Emissions from buildings account for almost 50% of carbon released.

Anything that uses energy or burns fuel emits carbon; computers, photocopiers, chargers, lighting, air-conditioning and heating.

The City Central Tower, designed by Woods Bagot Adelaide, is the feature project for the GBCA's Melbourne Breakfast with the Stars, which is **SOLD OUT!**

City Central was South Australia's first 5 Star Green Star - Office Design rated building, and is also the largest Green Star certified project to date. The design features large open plan floor plates which are linked to a three storey naturally ventilated atrium, providing high levels of natural daylight and fresh air and improving indoor environmental quality.

Sustainable initiatives includes:

- Light sensor controlled lighting
- Passive chilled beam technology
- Minimised supplementary air-conditioning
- Automated internal blinds linked to sensors
- Demountable partitions
- Low Volatile Organic Compounds
- Toxin absorbing plants
- FSC certified timbers

City Central is the largest Green Star development in Australia and is the first speculative building in the country to require the tenants to demonstrate environmental and energy performance criteria. For more information refer to the Green Building Council web site or click on the link -
